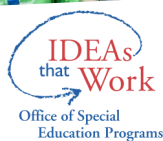

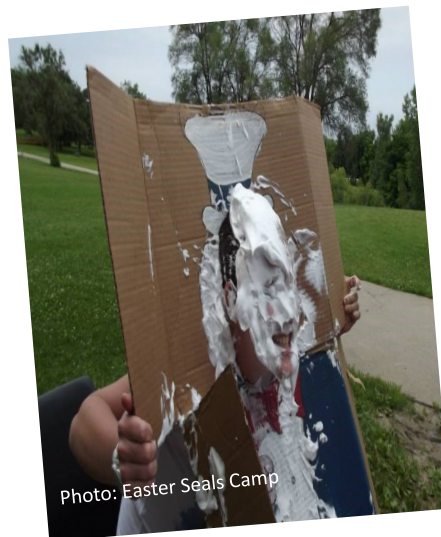

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE & SCHOLARSHIPS

ASK Resource Center does not provide scholarships or stipends for the programs on this list. If your family is in need of financial assistance in order to send your child to a camp or program, you are encouraged to contact the camp or program directly, or check with local faith communities, charities, or philanthropic groups in your area.

CHILDREN AT HOME The Children at Home program helps families of children with disabilities (up to age 22) by providing financial assistance for services not covered by other programs. For eligibility and application information visit www.iafamilysupportnetwork.org/children-at-home.

FLEX CARE Many employers offer tax deferred dependent care programs, also known as “flex care,” that may consider day camp an allowable expense for reimbursement (overnight camps are not eligible). Refer to the guidelines for your specific plan, or ask your employer if this is an option for you.
