PARENT MENTORS – Trained parents who have been where you are can connect with you to share stories, answer questions and offer emotional support.

DEAF MENTORS – Extensively trained Deaf/Hard of Hearing adults can serve as your Deaf Role Model PLUS provide information about communication choices and teach basic American Sign Language.
